Exception to rule 3121 "All Registered Palomino Bred Cremello colored horses will be allowed to show in the respective age and class as those registered as regular registry. Carmelo's shown in regular registry class would not be eligible to show in the Palomino Bred Classes and Vice Versa.

Justification

's justification for change and impact if not passed: (Proposal will be return if not completed)

According to university California Davis any Cremello bred to Bay, Brown, Chestnut, Sorrel, will produce the palomino color 100% of the time. A Palomino bred to those same colors would have at best 50% probably to produce Palomino. With these odds a knowledgeable breeder would be breeding to cremello's more often than not. Therefore as a move to continue to improve the Palomino breed we need these Cremello horses in the ring side by side being judged on confirmation. Note: Rule 3352-A. requires that 10% of the judges score must be based on color thereby always giving the Palomino Color the 10% edge in every class. Allowing Cremello's in same class would also increase the entry numbers and revenue for show management.
