TRAIL SCORE SHEET

1/2 point penalty: Each tick of log, pole, cone, plant or any component of the obstacle

1 point penalties: each hit, bite or stepping on a log, cone, plant or any component of the obstacle; Incorrect or break of gait at walk or jog for two strides or less; Both front or hind feet in a single strided slot or space at a walk or jog; Skipping over or failing to step into required space; Spilt pole in lope over; Incorrect number of strides, if specified.

3 point penalties: Incorrect or break of gait at walk or jog for more than 2 strides; Out of lead or break of gait at lope (except when correcting an incorrect lead); Knocking down an elevated pole, cone, barrel, plant obstacle or severly distribing an obstacle; Stepping outside of the confines of, falling or jumping off or out of obstacle with one foot once the foot has entered obstacle: Missing one element of an obstacle on a line of travel with one foot.

5 point penalties: Droppong slicker or object required to be carried on course; First or second cumulative refusal, balk, or evading an obstacle by shying or backing more than two (2) strides; Letting go of the gate or dropping the rope; Use of hand to instill fear or praise; Stepping outside the confines of, falling or jumping off or out of an obstacle with more than one foot once the foot has entered obstacle; including missing one element of an obstacle on a line of travel with more than one foot; Blatant disobedience (kicking out, bucking, rearing striking); Holding saddle with either hand.

Disqualification 0 Score: Use of more than one finger between split reins; Use of two hands (exception snaffle bit or bosal classes designated for two hands) or changing hands on reins; except for junior horses shown with bosal or snaffle bit, only one hand may be used on the reins, except that it is permissible to change hands to work an obstacle; Use of romal other than as outline in Rule(s) 3315; Performing the obstacles incorrectly or other than in specified order; No attempt to perform an obstacle; Equipment failure that delays completion of pattern; Excessively or repeatedly touching the horse on the neck to lower the head; Fall to the ground by horse or rider; Failure to enter, exit or work obstacle from correct side of direction including overturns of more than 1/4 turn; Failure to work an obstacle in any manner other than how it's described by the course; Riding outside designated boundary marker of the course; Failure to ever demonstrate correct lead and/or gait, if designated; Failure to follow the course or correct line of travel between obstacles; Third refusal; Willful abuse; Illegal equipment; Excessive schooling, pulling, turning, stepping or backing anywhere on the course; Failure to open and shut gate or failure to complete gate (except for novice classes where they place below all who complete course correctly).
