The two (2) containers for flags shall be either two (2) or two and a half (2 1/2) gallon plastic buckets without obstructions, such as bails or ears. Material in containers should be loose sand or arena dirt and filed to within a half (1/2) inch of the top of each bucket. Buckets shall be set on the outside edge of the barrels with the flag in the center of the bucket. The flag sticks are to be fourteen (14) inches long and one half (1/2) inch in diameter wooden dowel rods with blunt ends and with a three (3) inch marker on the flag stick to indicate how deep to put the flag down in the dirt. One (1) six (6) inch by eight (8) inch rectangular flag shall be securely attached to the flag stick as to not cause injury upon retrieval or disposal of the flag.
