An Exhibitor may request Reining Classes run concurrently if an exhibitor is eligible to show in multiple classes. This applies to all Reining Class(es). An entry fee and any additional charges will be paid for each class entered. An exhibitor may not request class be run concurrently once the class has begun or have score roll over to any other class that has already been held.

Originator's justification for change and impact if not passed: (Proposal will be return if not completed)

This could potentially increase the number of entries in multiple reining classes. Reining is very physically demanding on both horse and exhibitor. It is very difficult for a horse to run a reining pattern in back to back classes. If classes were run concurrently, this would open up the opportunity for exhibitors to enter a horse in multiple classes without undue stress on either horse or exhibitor.
