- 2. A Show Roster and the Horse/Show Entry Roster will now be required for each judge instead of one for each day.*
- 3. The PHBA office will verify these notifications to the original judges' cards submitted.*
- 4. If they do not match then these reports will be returned to the show secretary/manager for correction.*
