Moreover this change

accounts for the inconsistency in the judging of the color classes. To offset removing this criteria the points shall be increased for the color + halter. Although I recognize this should be a challenge to earn, the award needs to mirror the reality of our shows & judges judging to truly be reflective our real champions.
