Exhibiting Multiple Horses. In individual working events (Dally Team Roping, Heeling, Dally Team Roping Heeling, Ranch Riding, Trail) a rider may:
A. Exhibit (1) horse in a Junior class
B. Exhibit (1) horse in a Senior class
C. Exhibit a maximum (total) of two (2) horses in an all age class
There is no requirement for the number of Junior horses and number of senior horses in an all age class.

Originator's justification for change and impact if not passed: (Proposal will be return if not completed)

I feel that it is not fair to All exhibitors when ~~some~~ certain classes have the allowance of riding more than one (1) horse per exhibitor. When allowing 1 rider to ride multiple horses (currently 3) in certain classes, that exhibitor can make their own class or pool their own class & select the horse they want the points in making it unfair to those riding in classes that you can only ride (1) one horse in.

Estimated revenue to association with rule change Most exhibitors riding multiple horses are on horses that are already Maxed out so no additional Revenue w/ them going in additional classes.

Estimated expense to association with rule change \$0. Zero - it costs the Show/PPA sometimes because people showing just 1 horse will not enter if others are showing multiples. Savings of Operating any to judges & office

Classes that commonly have & make for Both Junior & Senior Divisions this change still allows them to ride 1 Junior & 1 Senior horse for a total of two (2) in an all age class.
