Use to submit a rule change proposal (must be postmarked 120 days prior to convention)

A rule or regulations is not subject to amendment by change, addition or repeal, until it has been in force for at least two calendar years, which limitations may be waived by the Executive Board upon finding extraordinary circumstances: A. Concerns the safety, health or well being of a horse and/or rider; B. Materially benefits PHBA's programs or it financial stability; or C. Involves other compelling circumstances.

A: Unlike one that has been submitted that says (all must show at 4 different/separate venues. Most states use the same venues for cost reasons, etc.

Qualifying period January 1st – December 31st the year prior.

Exception to rule: Weanlings, yearlings, and 2 yr olds do not have to qualify.

At the shows/show office can sign a form that the exhibitor and horse/horses did show at that show.
