A rule or regulation is not subject to amendment by change, addition or repeal, until it has been in force for at least two calendar years, which limitations may be waived by the Executive Board upon finding extraordinary circumstances: A. Concerns the safety, health or well being of a horse and/or rider; B. Materially benefits PHBA's programs or its financial stability; or C. Involves other compelling circumstances.

Originator's recommendation for change: (Rule should be written as it should appear in the Rule Book)

Rule 3001, B - For horse show approval, any APA, organization, or individual shall send a current properly completed show application to PHBA with appropriate fees postmarked at least ninety (90) days prior to the date of entry dates of the horse show. If two applications are received for the same numbered weekend, the horse show application with the earliest postmark will be eligible for approval of that date.

Rule 3006 – **Late Horse Show Approvals.** Horse show approval applications postmarked less than ninety (90) days, but more than sixty (60) days prior to the date of the horse show shall require an additional \$100.00 per judge late penalty fee.

Originator's justification for change and impact if not passed: (Proposal will be return if not completed)

These rules were originally written to allow time for approved shows to be published in Palomino Horse Magazine. Since that publication is no longer published in print, the one hundred twenty (120) day time frame is no longer necessary.

Shortening the show approval time frame would be beneficial to local clubs giving more time to complete show planning, class lists, hire judges before submitting show approval application. It might also encourage more show approvals.

This new time frame will also follow most other breed's show approval time frames. Since smaller clubs often run shows with other breed shows, this would be beneficial.
