REINING PATTERN NUMBER 11

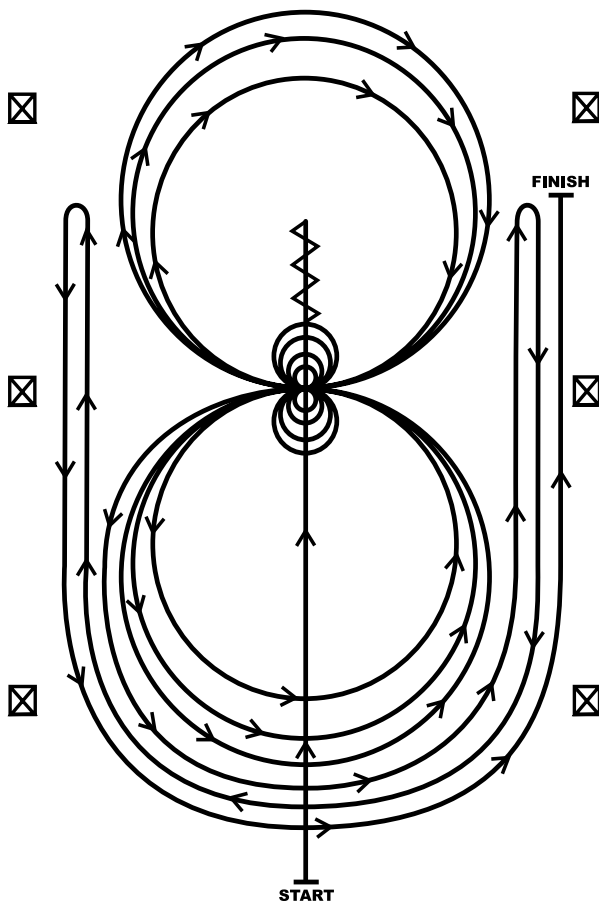


Horses must jog the majority of the way to the center. Failure to jog the majority of the way to the center will result in 0 for failure to complete the pattern as written. horse must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circles small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
4. Complete three circles to the left: the first circles small and slow; the two circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
5. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run down the center of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback - no hesitation.
6. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback. - no hesitation.
7. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

The bridle may be dropped at the judge's discretion.

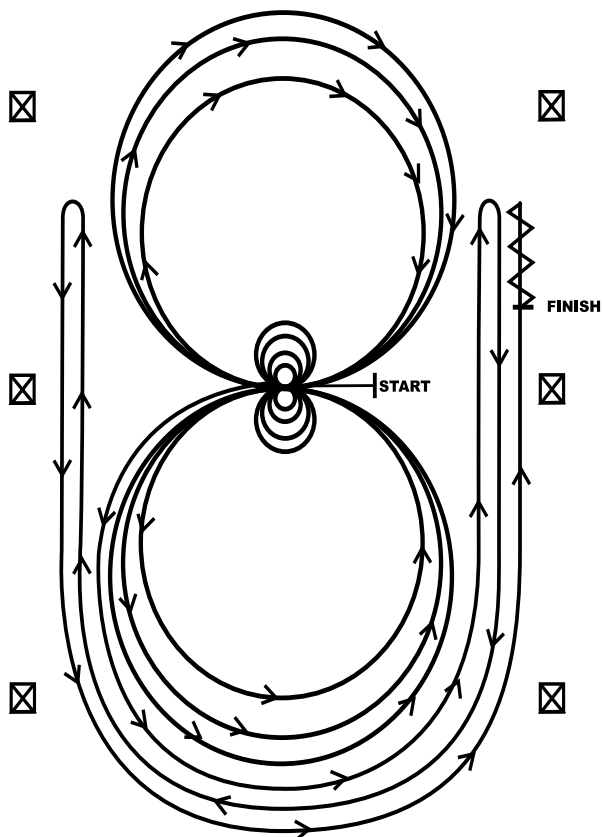
REINING PATTERN NUMBER 12



1. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate
2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate
3. Complete four and one-quarter spins to the left so that the horse is facing the left wall or fence. Hesitate.
4. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast: the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
5. Complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast: the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
6. Begin a large circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least twenty feet (six Meters) from the wall or fence - no hesitation.
7. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena and past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet (six Meters) from the wall or fence - no hesitation..
8. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena and past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six Meters) from the wall or fence - no hesitation.

The bridle may be dropped at the judge's discretion.

REINING PATTERN NUMBER 13

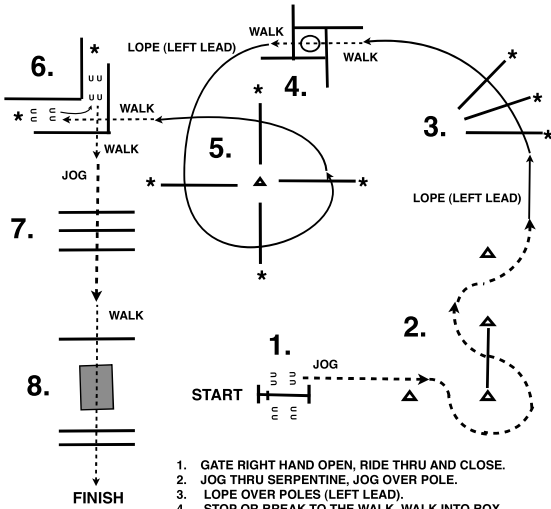


Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the left lead, complete two circles to the left: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena
2. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the right lead, complete two circles to the right: the first being large and fast; the second circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena.
4. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
5. Beginning on the left lead, run a large fast circle to the left, change leads at the center of the arena, run a large fast circle to the right, and change leads at the center of the arena.
6. Continue around previous circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence-no hesitation.
7. Continue around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence-no hesitation.
8. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least 10 feet (3 meters).

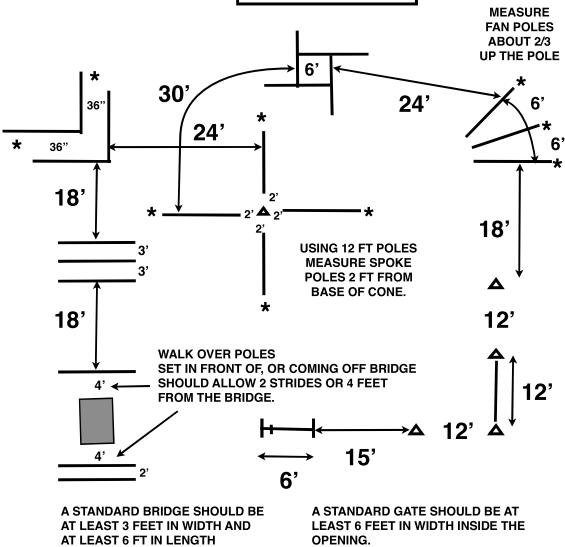
Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern. Rider may drop bridle to the designated judge.

SAMPLE TRAIL

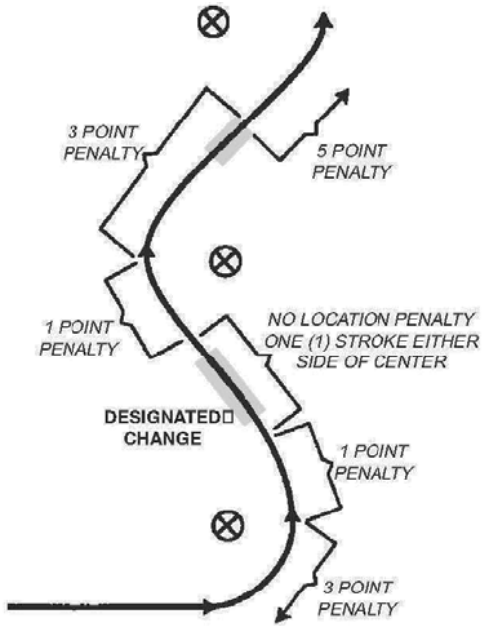


1. GATE RIGHT HAND OPEN, RIDE THRU AND CLOSE.
2. JOG THRU SERPENTINE, JOG OVER POLE.
3. LOPE OVER POLES (LEFT LEAD).
4. STOP OR BREAK TO THE WALK, WALK INTO BOX, 360 TURN EITHER DIRECTION, WALK OUT BOX.
5. LOPE OVER SPOKE (LEFT LEAD).
6. STOP OR BREAK TO THE WALK, WALK INTO "L" BACK AROUND CORNER, WALK OUT "L".
7. JOG OVER POLES.
8. STOP OR BREAK TO THE WALK, WALK OVER POLES AND OVER BRIDGE.

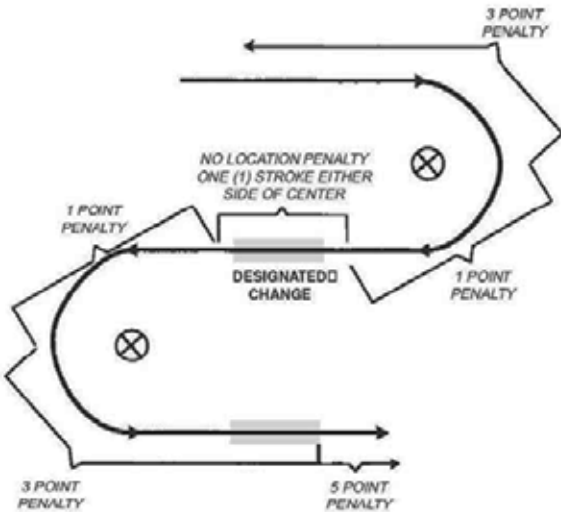

LOCATION PENALTIES FOR DESIGNATED CHANGE**

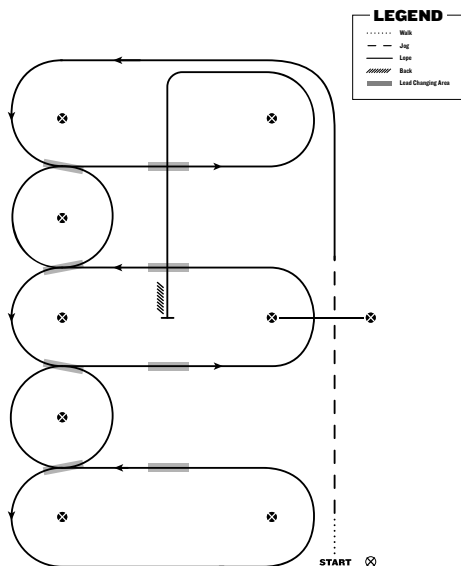


LEAD CHANGING AREA



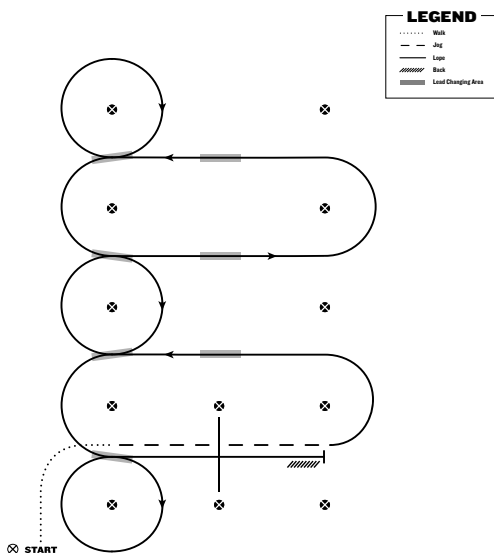
